

iate Basic search - Interpreters' view

1 Enter a term/string/ID that you want to search for

2 Select a domain and indicate whether lower levels should be included

3 Choose at least 1 source and 1 target language. You can define the order of the languages displayed in your user preferences. If you are not logged in, you can only select 1 source language.

4 Define more filters for your search (e.g. confidentiality, owner or reliability). Some filters are available under 'Show more'.

5 Launch your search

9 Review your search criteria. Click on filters (domains, collections, owners, primaryity) to remove them from your search criteria

10 Download your search results as a table or termbase (internal users only)

11 Add the entry to your bookmarks to retrieve it quickly (registered users only)

15 Click on the entry ID to open the full entry for consultation

16 Click on a term to display the main term metadata (owner, reliability and validation status)

17 Click on the icons to display additional information on the entry and selected term/language

18 Select a term (in bold) to display additional information. Then click on the icons to display term reference, definition, language level note, term in context, term note, and additional information, or expand all at once. If the field is empty, so is the icon.

6 Display your last queries (you can save a query or run it again)

7 Switch between views

8 Set your preference for searches, results and full entry view display options under 'User preferences' (registered users only)

12 Refine your search by primaries, domains, owners, collections (hold CTRL to select several)
